His answer is pretty much verbatim to what he says in episode 1 so it may be implied that he is Kim Shin (the lead). However, since there's no confirmation of who he is at this stage, we'll just leave him as Unknown.

The Thug who calls himself "Chal" is played by Kim Il-Seok (김일석), a martial arts expert and former Muay Thai fighter from South Korea who is also a retired police officer. Originally, Chal was referred to as "Chal Ja", literally meaning "Salute". However, this was changed to "Chal Ja" because it sounded like it could be a shortened version of "Chal Jang", literally meaning "Thief's Alley". It also didn't fit in with the way other names were made up. The original reason for choosing the name is because he lives in a poor area called "Thieves' Alley" where many thieves operate after dark.
